

General Information about Scholarships at St Cuthbert's

St Cuthbert's offers a range of Scholarships - Academic, Boarding, Performing Arts and General Excellence.

Applications are invited from talented students for entry in 2021.

- **All scholarships are open to prospective students only.** Students must be New Zealand citizens or hold New Zealand residency visas.
- To be awarded the maximum value of the scholarship you will need to complete our financial needs assessment.
- In the event of there being no candidate who reaches a sufficiently high standard, a scholarship may not be awarded.
- The decision of the Principal is final, and no correspondence will be entered in to.
- You will receive an acknowledgement of the receipt of your application by email.

You may apply for more than one Scholarship.

Timeline

- Applications open on **Saturday 1 February 2020**.
- Applications close on **Wednesday 25 March 2020**.
- Scholarship examinations will take place on **Thursday 2 April 2020** from 9.00-11.00am.
- Applicants applying for a Performing Arts Scholarship will be emailed with information about their audition.
- All applicants, both successful and unsuccessful, will be notified of the outcome of their application by email.
- Personal interviews will be held for candidates who are short-listed on **Thursday 30 April 2020**. There is no alternative interview date.

There has been one significant change to our 2021 scholarship programme. We no longer offer a music scholarship for Year 7 entry. Our Performing Arts Scholarships for Year 9 entry are offered in Music, Dance and Drama. The Performing Arts Scholarship has a maximum value of 50% of tuition fees.

Scholarships at St Cuthbert's for Entry in 2021

Academic Scholarships

1. Macdonald Junior Academic Scholarship 2021
 - For entry to Year 7 2021
 - Strong academic ability
 - Involvement in cultural, sporting and/or community activities
 - **The scholarship has a maximum value of 75% of tuition fees**
2. Macdonald Senior Academic Scholarship 2021
 - For entry to Year 9 2021 and Year 11 2021
 - Strong academic ability
 - Involvement in cultural, sporting and/or community activities
 - **The scholarship has a maximum value of 100% of tuition fees**

Boarding Scholarships

3. Trust Board Boarding Scholarships 2021
 - For entry to Year 9 2021 and Year 11 2021
 - The student must be motivated and achieving well at her local school
 - The student must live at a distance greater than 30 km from the College
 - **The scholarship has a maximum value of 100% of boarding fees per annum**
 - Tuition fees are **NOT** included in a Boarding Scholarship
4. Edith Whittaker Boarding Scholarship 2021
 - For entry to Year 9 2021
 - The student must be motivated and achieving well at her local school
 - The student must live at a distance greater than 30 km from the College
 - **The scholarship has a maximum value of 50% of boarding fees per annum**
 - Tuition fees are **NOT** included in a Boarding Scholarship

Performing Arts Scholarships

5. Trust Board Performing Arts Scholarships 2021

- For entry to Year 9 2021
- For a talented Dance, Drama, or Music student
- The successful student will be required to participate fully in the cultural and performance opportunities at the College
- The successful student will be required to attend regular meetings with their Artistic Mentor during the school year
- **The scholarship has a maximum value of 50% of tuition fees**
- Criteria:
 - Dance
 - Technical and creative excellence with Distinction or Honours at Elementary level for ballet, Grade 6 or above for contemporary or lyrical, intermediate one or elementary three for jazz
 - The successful student will be required to take Dance as an Academic subject option from Year 9 to Year 13
 - Applicants are required to attend an audition and present two contrasting dance performances
 - Drama
 - Technical and creative excellence with Distinction or Honours at Grade 5 or above in Trinity College Speech & Drama exams **OR** Performance in a significant role in Theatre or Stage productions
 - The successful student will be required to take Drama as an Academic subject option from Year 9 to Year 13
 - Applicants are required to attend an audition and present two contrasting drama performances
 - Music
 - Technical and musical excellence at Grade 5 or above in main instrument (not voice)
 - Preferably competent in two instruments (second instrument may be voice)
 - The successful student will be required to take Music as an academic subject option for Year 9, Year 10 and Year 11
 - Applicants are required to attend an audition and play two contrasting pieces of music

General Excellence Scholarships

6. Kathleen Goulding Old Girls' Association Scholarship 2021
 - For entry to Year 9 2021
 - Strong academic ability and general excellence
 - **This scholarship has a maximum value of 75% of tuition fees**

7. Margaret Beale Scholarship 2021
 - For entry to Year 9 2021
 - Strong academic ability and general excellence
 - Demonstrated ability in sport
 - **This scholarship has a maximum value of 100% of tuition fees**
